JOB FAMILY: STATISTICAL ANALYSIS Level A, Pay Grade 7

LEVEL DEFINITION	This level covers positions that perform research statistical analyses
TYPICAL RESPONSIBILITIES	May include: consulting with or advising researchers on study design, analysis and the type of application of statistical methods; interpreting statistical results; evaluating statistical programmes and packages; extracting information for research analysis; participating in preparing presentations and publications.
DECISION MAKING /LEVEL OF ACCOUNTABILITY	Makes professional decisions. Accountable for the delivery and reliability of their work.
SUPERVISION RECEIVED	Works under general direction. Performance subject to review.
SUPERVISION EXERCISED	May give technical guidance to support staff.
MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS	Post-graduate degree in Statistics. Minimum of two years of related experience in research analysis, or the equivalent combination of education and experience.
