## **Choosing an Office Chair**

Below is an outline of the key features to consider. Please note that this checklist and is meant to be used as a guideline; depending on the needs of your group, certain features may be more important to you and thus given more weight.

This guideline was developed in accordance with BIFMA guidelines, WorkSafe BC "How to Make Your Computer Workstation Fit You" and the ANSI-HFES 100-2007 Checklist.

It is recommended that you always **trial chairs prior to purchase**, for examples of chairs with appropriate support and adjustability features, please see <u>Office Chair Examples</u>, p.3

Feature	Recommendations & Considerations:
Courtesy of: Global Total Office  Feet should be supported firmly on the ground/footrest  Knees at approximately 90°	<ul> <li>→ Height Adjustable: Range: 15 to 19.9"</li> <li>→ Can the chair be ordered in different sizes, if the above range doesn't fit everyone?</li> </ul>
Seat Depth & Width  Courtesy of: Global Total Office  Seat should support full thigh without cutting into calf; i.e. 2 to 3 fingers between the edge of the chair and the calf	<ul> <li>Waterfall edge</li> <li>Preferred: Adjustable seat depth (if not adjustable must be less than 16.9")</li> <li>Width: 18" (unless ordering for smaller workers)</li> <li>Can the chair be ordered in different sizes if the above seat depth/width doesn't fit everyone?</li> </ul>

Feature	Recommendations & Considerations:		
Courtesy of: Global Total Office  Lumbar support should fit the small of the back	<ul> <li>Backrest Height: Minimum 12.2"; WSBC recommends minimum of 17.7"</li> <li>Backrest or lumbar support should be height adjustable</li> <li>Lumbar support should be between 5.9 and 9.8" above the seat height</li> <li>Backrest angle: Should support upright and allow at least 15° reclined posture</li> <li>Should allow adjusting the angle between the backrest and seat pan to an angle of 90° or greater</li> <li>Dynamic recline must have tension control</li> </ul>		
A reclined posture reduces pressure on the discs in the low back			
Courtesy of: Global Total Office  Armrests should support the elbows in 90 degrees of flexion	<ul> <li>Height adjustable: 6.9 to 10.8" above seat</li> <li>Preferred: width adjustable (if not, width between armrest should be at least 18")-user should be able to use the armrest with less than 20° of shoulder abduction</li> <li>Armrests should not cause excessive pressure points or irritate the skin; i.e. no ridges</li> <li>Armrests should be removable if they prevent the user from getting in close to their workstation</li> <li>Avoid chairs with loop armrests that are not adjustable</li> </ul>		
Other things to consider:	<ul> <li>Customizability</li> <li>Environment:</li> <li>Greenguard</li> <li>Recyclable or made from recycled product</li> <li>BIFMA Environmental Level</li> <li>ISO 14001</li> <li>Warranty</li> <li>Delivery/Assembly</li> <li>Aesthetics; fit with workstation</li> </ul>
