The Pharmacists Clinic at the UBC Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences will be conducting a study to evaluate a model of group appointments for people living with migraine. This study consists of a three-part series of pharmacist-led migraine group appointments. These free group appointments will be facilitated by faculty member pharmacists who have experience working with people living with migraine. These sessions will cover a variety of topics including the causes of migraines, treatment options, and group discussions surrounding experiences and migraine management.
