Mount Pleasant was Vancouver's first suburb and has undergone gentrification since the early 1990s, resulting in a remarkable assortment of historic buildings and modern developments. Spectacular views of the North Shore Mountains resting behind the dazzling cityscape add much to the splendor of this vibrant neighbourhood, which is home to the celebrated Olympic Village.




